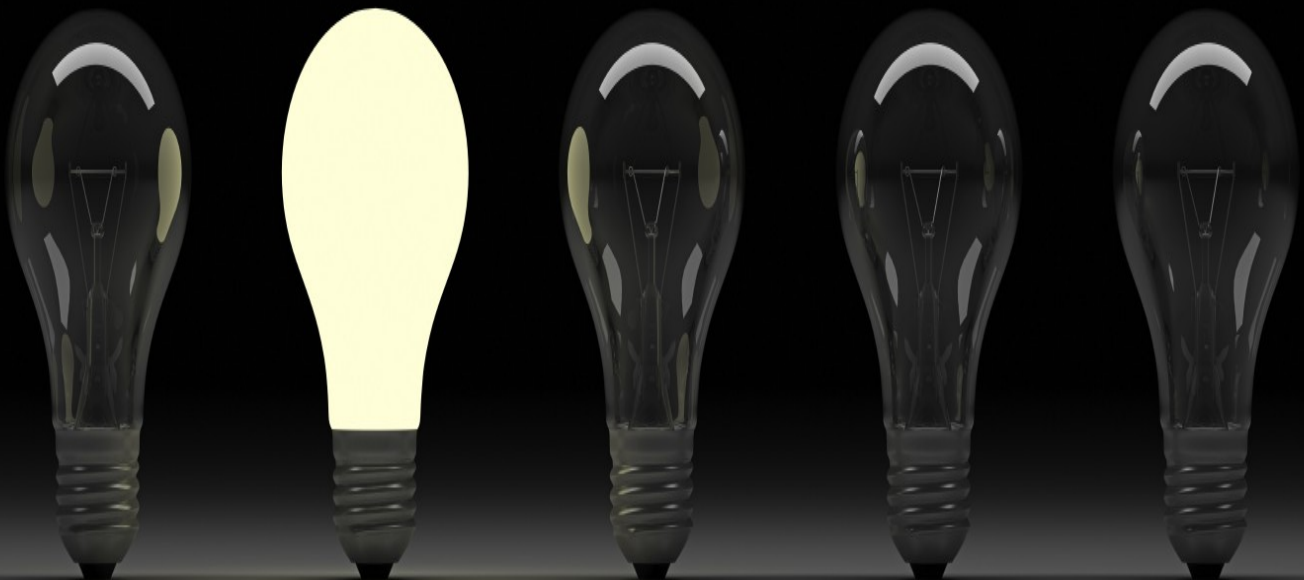

Paper's Abstract: The Great Pyramids of Giza, MG1, MG2, and MG3, were constructed, *from the bottom to the top, and from the middle out*, Obelisk fashion, using advanced and sophisticated Civil, Material, Mechanical, Thermodynamic, Construction, and Mining Engineering systems, from and within Mount Giza, an est. 700' vertical limestone Butte of the Mokattam Formation, by an advanced Civilization predating Dynastic Egypt, for the purpose of transferring all knowledge and science to any later Civilization.



- The primary question of this research and study was *how* were the Great Pyramids of Giza built? The secondary questions, *who* built them and *when*, precisely *what* they are and *why* they exist, are explored as conclusions resulting from the primary question's answer.
- The causal concept, *from the bottom to the top, and from the middle out*, suggested the build occurred outward from an Obelisk core within a quarried vertical construction shaft, which led to Mount Giza as the necessary assumption for the hypothesis.
- Indeed, it appears the Mokattam Formation that crests at the Giza Plateau would have an est. 700' potential rise, as evidenced by the formation's eastern crest at Mokattam Mountain, 8.4 miles east of Giza, its summit being 715' above sea level.
- This unique possible starting point, a never before proposed beginning for the Giza Plateau suggested a complex build process whereby three vertical construction shafts, each with an eastern regulatory Civil system access drain, would be mined within Mount Giza under a surface surveying template, at the locales for MG1-2-3, providing for precise plumbing of all pyramid faces and edges. Each shaft would then be quarried outward and encompassing columns would be added to the Obelisk core in the center of the construction shafts until MG1-2-3 were fully constructed within the cavernous shafts, the remainder of Mount Giza would then be excavated to its current topography.
- From this possible beginning arose a perspective from which to view practically every stone of the Giza Plateau. New purpose and function for nearly every shaft and chamber within MG1-2-3 are presented within the paper's 33 construction Arenas.
- Complete interdependent Engineering systems drive the project, those of furnace and foundry operations, mechanics, Civil systems, pump stations, steam generation, compression, injection, and ultimately, the firing of a 30,000 lb. piston within what is commonly know as the “Grand Gallery”, whose linear rope pull force is then transferred to



the northern and southern transmission, exiting the “Kings” and “Queens” chambers through the “air vents”, then rotate, by way of the alternating and opposing linear force from the dual acting piston, an integrated flywheel system, providing timing and circular force generation at the top of Mount Giza.

- Indeed, the apparent answers to *how* they were built shatter every historical and conceivable notion about the Plateau and the structures, in addition, the paper's 34th Arena, conclusions and discussion resulting from the *how*, begin to answer the secondary questions of *who* and *when*, by the definite time criteria set forth by Mount Giza's excavation after pyramid construction, in that no single constructed tomb would exist where Mount Giza existed until after the mountain was taken down. The mountain came down before the first and oldest tomb structure on the Plateau. This was before the second Dynasty, as the Wadi cemetery, west of MG1 on the northern ridge of the Mokattam Formation, contains second Dynasty tombs.
- The Great Pyramids, MG1-2-3, were resting on the Plateau as modern Man came out of Africa. This conclusion leads to an analysis of Early Nile Man's actions and reactions, those of burial ceremonies, ascension belief systems, iconography, discovery of tools and build plans, the creation of the Isis and Osiris Mythology, the introduction of the Obelisk and east facing false doors, and ultimately all building of similar pyramidal structures globally which would have resulted from exposure to/or knowledge of MG1-2-3.
- A precise *when*, which appears can best be established by the astrological alignment to the Constellation of Orion's belt, suggests 10,500 B.C.E., or any other processional alignment with his belt, leaping backward in time by 24,000 year increments into Paleolithic Stone Age history.



- It appears Plato's Atlantis, hitherto perceived and discounted by Academia exclusively as fiction, would indeed be non-fiction.
- Lastly, as evidenced by Early Nile Man's actions and reactions to MG1-2-3 and that of the discovered contents therein, the *what* and *why* present that in addition to the inherent and intentional mathematical and Geo-significant geometries of the structures themselves, the Constructors included all known science to be transferred to the discovering Civilization. It's suggested the Great Pyramids were and are an all inclusive time capsule, similar to any other time capsule or gene bank that any Civilization might construct.
- This much is a summary of Mount Giza-The Shaft Build, further work and research continue in nearly every Arena of the project, and the hypothesis' conclusions promise a complete rewriting of modern Man's history.

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
